Community Impact


Camp Fire Columbia has been part of the Oregon community since its founding in 1910 and remains a leader among the national Camp Fire network for inclusivity and belonging. We believe in putting relationships first and prioritize responsive program development in partnership with youth, families, and community. Our mission to build lasting, equitable, and caring relationships with nature, others, and ourselves is enacted daily.

As the largest Camp Fire organization in the United States, we annually serve 4,000 young people ages 5-18 through our Before & After School, Camp Namanu, and Teen Programs. Our area of impact has grown over the years, and we are honored to be in 27 schools in the districts of David Douglas, McMinnville, Portland Public Schools, Reynolds, West Linn-Wilsonville. We prioritize schools that are either under-resourced and/or have a large population of BIPOC students as part of our commitment to equity.

Through our top-notch staff, amazing volunteers, and superb supporters, we share power with youth, honor and protect the natural world, and strengthen student achievement. Our programs are based in best practices that support youth in goal setting and feeling confident in their ability to reach those goals. We believe that every young person should have the opportunity to find and nurture their spark.

Before & After School

Offered at 20 school sites across 3 school districts, our Before and After School (BAS) program is on track to serve over 900 young people and their families this year. Much more than just a fun place to hang out, Camp Fire extends the learning day and immerses kids in enriching experiences that are exciting, educational, and helps each child discover their interests and develop their talents. Young people at Camp Fire overwhelmingly experience growth in key developmental areas, including positive social behaviors, confidence, self-esteem, and teamwork.

Teen Programs

Our Teen Programs are comprised of embedded programming at the Middle School and High School levels. In 2022, we served 275 young people and maintained a ratio of 1 mentor per 25 teens. Our onsite, school-based staff build developmental relationships with students by expressing care, challenging growth, providing support, sharing power, and expanding possibilities. Camp Namanu established 1924

Camp Namanu has 552 acres of forest, meadow, and trails to explore with campers, renters, and community members. The camp is located on the banks of the Sandy River: on the unceded land of the Molalla, Kalapuya, Chinook, and Clackamas tribes.

During the summer, Camp Namanu serves over 1,300 youth aged 7-17 years old. Using a progressive program model, campers are exposed to new and advancing program activities as they age-up. Camp activities include soap-carving, weaving (Namanu hosts the nation's only remaining summer camp weavery program), a high and low ropes course, archery, fire building, swimming, playing games on the meadow, and joining in camp songs.



Oregon Historical Society Exhibit

March-May 2024

Camp Namanu, A 100 Year Journey of Inclusion, will celebrate the 100th anniversary of Camp Namanu and tell the story of one organization's journey from cultural appropriation to cultural inclusion. The exhibit will be open from March-May 2024 in the 550 square-foot mezzanine of the Oregon Historical Society, which receives about 44,000 visitors annually.

This multimedia exhibition will feature a visual timeline telling the rich history of Camp Namanu through panels, memorabilia, artifacts, audio, and films that captured the 75th and 90th anniversaries of camp. With interactive QR codes, this exhibit will provide a wide range of ways for viewers to explore and engage with the information.

For a century, Camp Namanu has been the setting for summer adventure, new friendships, outdoor education, and personal discovery for an estimated 100,000 youth. Through this project, thousands of young people, families, friends of Namanu, and those previously unfamiliar with Camp Fire Columbia will be exposed to the impactful historical legacy of Camp Namanu.


