COVID PROTOCOLS

- Campers will no longer be required to complete an antigen or PCR test prior to their arrival at camp. However, during check-in all campers will participate in a health screening.
- Staff are required to have completed at least the primary series of a COVID-19 vaccine.
- If any staff or campers begin to experience any cold, flu, COVID-19, or other illness symptoms they are required to mask in shared spaces. They will also need to check-in with the health center staff to be evaluated.
- Depending on symptoms and severity the health center staff may ask someone to complete a COVID-19 test and/or be sent home until their symptoms have gone away.
- We will still be collecting COVID-19 vaccine information for all staff and campers as part of their health history form.
- We will no longer be utilizing cohorts, meaning staff and campers will no longer be required to mask when indoors or in mixed-group settings.
- This includes in the dining hall during meals, program areas, all-camp activities, etc.
- Staff will still be trained on how to disinfect spaces as part of our cleaning training, the best practices for hand washing, and hand sanitizer will be available on site.
