WHEN CAN I RENT CAMP NAMANU?

Rentals at Camp Namanu are mostly available on the weekends during the Spring and Fall. We have limited availability during the summer and winter dependent on group size, timing, and weather.

WHAT EVENTS CAN I HOST AT CAMP?

Camp Namanu can host a variety of rental types. Corporate retreats, youth programs, family reunions, and weddings are our most common clients but we are always looking to share our home with more groups. Reach out if you have specific questions about what we can handle!

WHERE IS CAMP NAMANU?

Camp Namanu is located near Mt. Hood outside of Sandy, Oregon. We own 552 acres of forested land at the intersection of the Bull Run River and the Sandy River.

Our Blue Wing Retreat package is great for a mid-size group looking to claim their own corner of camp. This package includes 4 cabins and our historic Blue Wing Lodge. Each cabin includes 6 bunks, 2 single beds, bathroom, shower and porch. The lodge includes bathroom, shower, kitchen, fireplace, and gathering space.

RUSTIC RIVERBEND RETREAT

Sleeping Capacity of up to 50

- Communal fire pit, outdoor firepit, and access to Old Oregon, the small gathering space with electricity and fireplace.

Enjoy a rustic weekend away in our Riverbend unit. Wake up to the sound of the river and the fresh smell of the forest in these 7 open air-cabins. The Riverbend unit includes a shared bathroom with 4 toilet stalls, sinks, and electricity. Included in the package is access to the Riverbend firepit, covered outdoor dining table, and Old Oregon Lodge, the enclosed communal space with benches, electricity, and fireplace.

TRILLIUM CABIN

Trillium Cabin is a rustic apartment style cabin tucked away behind Raker dining hall that provides a bit of privacy and all the amenities one might need for a long get away in the forest.

Peak Lodge is one of our beautiful A-frame buildings on the edge of the meadow. This open-concept cabin includes 4 beds on the main level and 2 in the open lofted area. This space includes kitchen, bathroom, living space, and stone fireplace.

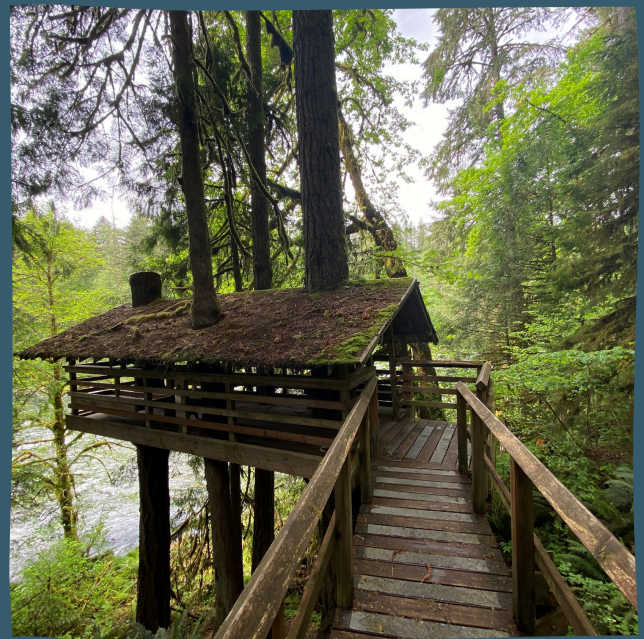


BALAGAN TREEHOUSES

Sleeping Capacity of 5 to 7

\$75 per night

For our most adventurous renters, the Balagan treehouses offer some of the best views in Camp. Overlooking the Sandy River, these cabins feature roofs and floors but little else. Bunks are surrounded by just railings and the sounds of the river.



GATHERING SPACES

RAKER LODGE

Capacity of 300

\$450 per day

Does not include use of kitchen

Raker Lodge is our primary Dining Hall here at Camp Namanu. With an industrial kitchen, a coffee station, two fireplaces, and countless windows this is where most meals on site are held.



UNCLE TOBY'S

Capacity of 300

Toby's Story House is the central gathering place for our Summer Camp Program. This large open-air barn includes a large stage, two fireplaces, and a wrap-around porch. Two lofts make up a split second story and natural light floods in from a skylight.



THE NATURE HOUSE

Capacity of 20

\$100 per day

Sitting above the meadow, half shrouded by trees, sits the Nature House. This small open air building equipped with stone floors and a fireplace is a great spot for private chats, roasting marshmallows, or setting up your event bar or drink station.

Blue Wing Lodge is the gathering place for Camp's youngest kids. This large open lodge includes a full kitchen, bathroom and large fireplace. The fireplace is surrounded by a small conversation pit and exposed beams hang overhead.



THE ART BARN

Capacity for up to 30

The Art Barn only has one wall to let the sights and sounds of the meadow in. Located on the edge of the heart of camp, this spot is perfect for cooling off out of the sun or playing board games in the evening. It is full of tables and the sounds of the creek that runs nearby.

The swimming pool and pond boats are limited to authorized and supervised events. Availability of the pool or pond is at the discretion of Namanu Staff. No one shall enter the pool or pond area unless a qualified lifeguard(s) is/are in the pool or pond area.

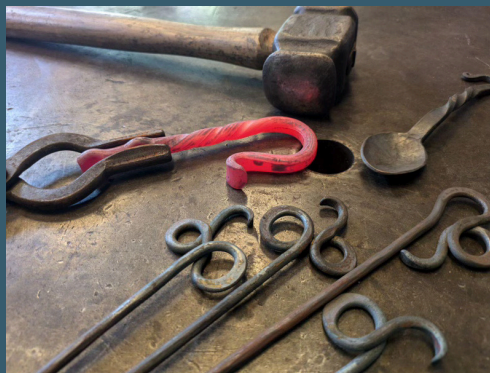

With over 2 decade sof experience Kellen will have you itching to take on a long forgotten hobby and skill.

KITCHEN RENTALS

For groups that aren't interested in our in-house catering or working with the smaller residential kitchens we have available, we also rent out our industrial kitchen in Raker Dining Hall.

This is our primary kitchen and offers plenty of stoves, a large flattop, industrial ovens, warmers, and a full dish pit.

We offer two rental options for our kitchen. One price is for private groups that want to rent the space themselves. The other is for catering services hired by private groups.

We do charge a higher fee for private groups using the space as we cannot be sure of their experience in an industrial kitchen.

We require that any individuals working in our kitchen have an up-to-date Oregon Food Handler's License.

The kitchen is expected to be cleaned and returned to the state that it was found in. Any lost or broken equipment will be replaced and charged to the renter.
